At this website you will find a map of the distribution of least developed countries. Describe the **pattern of distribution of the least developed countries**.

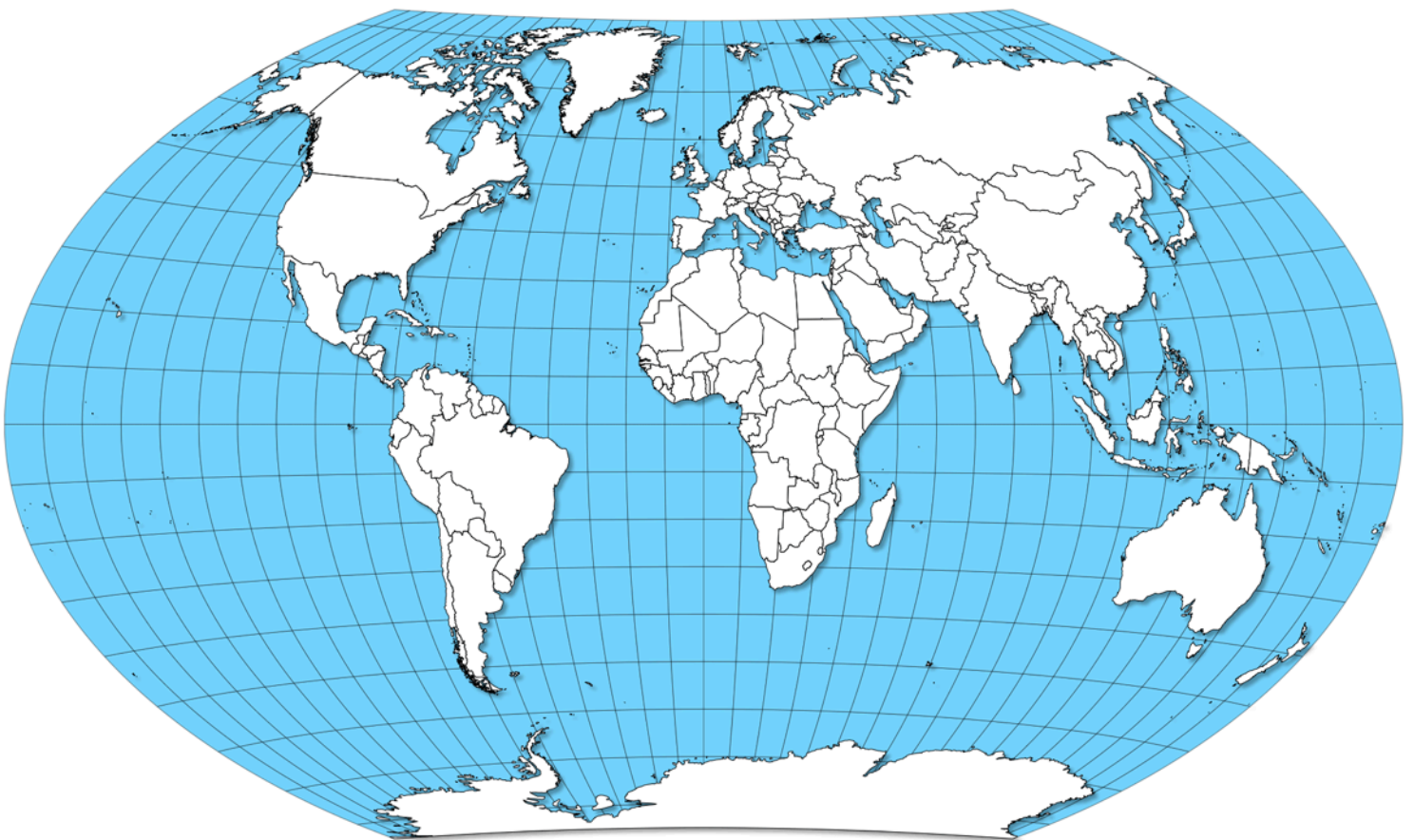
