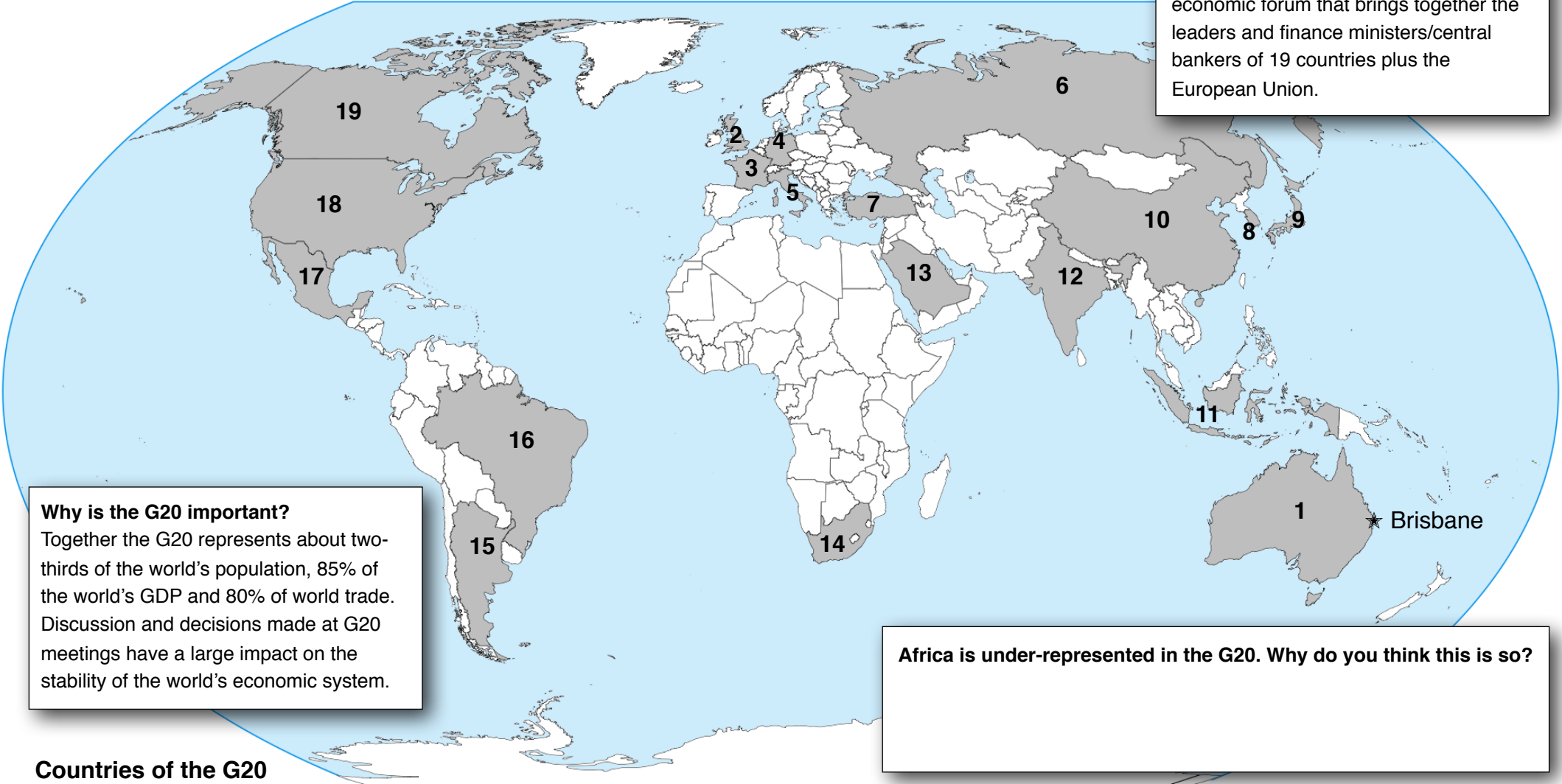


2014 G20 Summit - Brisbane

What is the G20?

The Group of 20 (G20) is the top economic forum that brings together the leaders and finance ministers/central bankers of 19 countries plus the European Union.



Why is the G20 important?
 Together the G20 represents about two-thirds of the world's population, 85% of the world's GDP and 80% of world trade. Discussion and decisions made at G20 meetings have a large impact on the stability of the world's economic system.
